

Clinical Equipment Check

- Defibrillator, pads, batteries, razor.
[Ready for Use, Indicator/Daily Shock Check]
- Paper roll
- Umbrella
- Blankets (min. x 2)
- Silver swaddler
- First Aid Kit
- Emesis bowls, urinals, bed pans + incontinence pads
- Spill kit
- Pocket mask
- Patient Drugs Bag
- SPAT Bag (2 x L, 2 x M)

Airway

- 6 x Oropharyngeal airways (2 x s4, 2 x s3 + 2 x s2)
- 1 x Adult Bag + valve mask
- 1 x Hand held suction + catheter

Oxygen

- 6 x Adult Duo mask
- 6 x Oxygen Tubing

Dressings Pouch

- 1 x Roll transpore/tape
- 6 x Dressings M, L, XL (2 of each)
- 2 x Water sachets
- 2 x Packets of swabs
- 2 x Triangular bandages

PTV 1 (additional)

- Complete set(s) of wheelchair and occupant restraints
- 'Y' strap accessory to winch wheelchairs (where applicable)
- Wheelchair back support as per vehicle model
- Oxygen size F + portable + spare cylinders
- Glidesheets
- Glideboard
- Turning disc
- Transfer belts (S + M + L)
- Drip hooks (if appropriate)

PTV 2 (additional)

- Trolley (appropriate to vehicle)
- Trolley clamps
- Orthopaedic stretcher (if issued)
- Spinal board (if issued)
- ACR (child restraint harness)
- Ibex / Stairclimber + battery / Compact Chair

PPE (check expiry dates)

- High Visibility Jacket & Gloves
 - Goggles
 - Safety glasses
 - FFP3 (face mask) x 2
 - Dust mask
 - Surgical masks x 2
 - Debris gloves
 - Chemical gloves
 - Ear protectors
 - Safety helmet
 - Tychem suit
 - Tough Cuts
- (per individual staff member)

Infection Control Equipment

- 2 x Black domestic bags
- 3 x Surgical masks
- 4 x FFP3 (face mask) (in addition to PPE)
- 2 x Red soluble linen bags
- D10 + Dispenser + Surface cleaning wipes
- 2 x White coveralls
- Disposable cloths
- Disposable aprons
- Moist skin wipes
- Personal/vehicle alcohol hand rub dispensers
- Body fluid spillage kit x 2, with biocide cleaner
- Clinical waste bags (2 x orange / 2 x yellow)
- Gloves (S,M,L,XL)
- Sharps bin + self adhesive labels for clinical

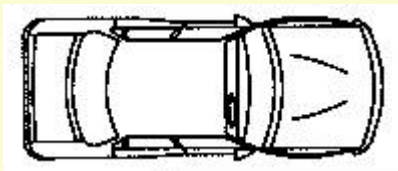
Administration

Vehicle Check (exterior)

Please ensure daily clean is carried out and documented

- Exterior of vehicle for damage
- Doors locks/exits
- All lights working (reflectors/number plates)
- Tyre pressures/condition/fixings (tyre pressure gauge)
- Reverse audible warning
- Fan belt (engine off: visual check for wear/tear (if possible))
- Water levels (screen bottle/leaks)
- Engine oil and water levels
- Cleanliness
- Start Engine
- Excessive engine exhaust smoke



Indicate any damage on vehicle with X

Vehicle Check (interior)

Please ensure daily clean is carried out and documented

- Fuel level (min ¾ full)
- Horn
- Heating/ventilation (cab and saloon)
- Mirrors/Windscreen glass + tax disc (date)
- Windscreen washer/wipers (may require exterior check in addition)
- Radio/Telephone check (radios to be carried on person)
- Brakes/Steering + driving controls test
- All seat belts + extensions (damage/worn/clips)
- External temperature gauge (ice detector)
- Brakes (stationary and moving) + steering and driving controls
- Fire extinguisher
- Tool roll + vehicle torch (where present)
- De-icer/scraper (winter months)
- Ramp/Winch/Tail lift/Air suspension
- Breakdown Triangle + Instructions
- Cleanliness
- Shovel

Shock Box Operators Checklist

FR2+

- Clean, no dirt or contamination, no signs of damage
- Defib. pads (2 x adult + 1 x paed), sealed, undamaged, within expiry date
- Spare M3863A battery, within "install before" date
- Data card, undamaged
- Swabs, razor
- Status indicator - alternating hourglass self test passed

FRX

- Clean, no dirt or contamination, no signs of damage
- 2 sets of Defib. pads, within expiry date, 1 set pre-connected
- Child key
- Swabs, razor
- Status indicator – green flashing light self test passed

First Person On Scene Medical Response Bag

Airway

- 1 x Bag + Valve Mask
- 6 x Oropharyngeal airways size 2, 3, and 4 (2 of each)
- 1 x Hand held Suction Unit + catheter

Oxygen

- 6 x Duo mask
- 6 x Oxygen tubing
- Portable oxygen

Miscellaneous

- 1 x Pen torch
- 2 x Triangular bandages
- 1 x Sharps box
- 1 x Silver swaddler
- 2 x Swabs
- 6 x Dressings (2 x Small, 2 x Medium, 2 x Large)
- 2 x Sterile water
- 2 x Roll transpore/tape
- 1 x Clinical waste bag
