Question

I would like request cost incurred by the Scottish Ambulance Service in repairing and servicing the Corpus Defibrillator from the 1st of January 2018 to the present date. Additionally, I am interested in understanding the costs associated with repairing and servicing the Philips MRX Defibrillator from 2012 to January 2018.

Answer

The Scottish Ambulance Service changed it's procurement system in September 2018, due to this change there is no information on costs before this date.

Please see a breakdown of the Corplus defib net spend from 2019-2024. The delivery costs are provided in a separate line as we are charged each time a device is picked-up and returned to us.
