### Question

I am looking for information regarding the number of SAS Paramedic and technician staff who have been registered as on sick leave due to mental health/ stress/anxiety. As such, can I request the following: The number of SAS Paramedic and technician staff on sick leave due to mental health/stress/anxiety from 01/05/23 to present, including a breakdown by location?

#### **Answer**

Please see the table below detailing the number of Paramedic and Technicians absent with a reason of Anxiety/Stress/Depression between 01/05/2023 - 30/04/2024. This information has been broken down by region; The Scottish Ambulance service has a duty, under the Data Protection Act to avoid directly or indirectly revealing any personal details. Any further breakdown of location would have the potential to make the information identifiable.
